Professional members shall have full rights to vote and hold office therein.

ASSOCIATE

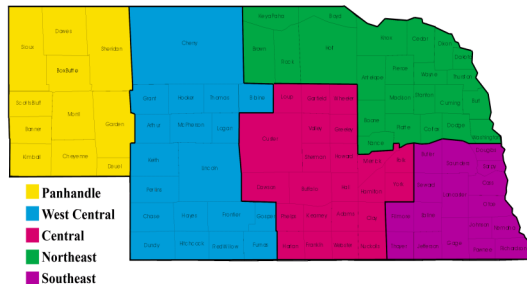
Associate membership is offered to business and industry, or any person who supports the goals and objectives of the Nebraska Association of Emergency Management, or who provides a service and/or product in the comprehensive field of emergency response. An Associate member shall have no voting privileges and must be sponsored by a Professional member.

RETIRED

Retired membership shall include a person working directly with emergency management, emergency services, or public service that is retired from full-time or part-time employment, and serves on a volunteer basis. Retired membership shall include any past professional member who is now retired.

DEPARTMENTAL

Department membership shall consist of Emergency Management Agencies that are part of a local political subdivision. Department Membership includes 6 (six) professional memberships. Each additional professional membership after 6 (six) is \$25. 00 per professional membership.

3. **Risk-Driven**—Use sound risk management principles in assigning priorities and resources.
4. **Integrated**—Ensure unity of effort among all levels of government, public, and private sector.
5. **Collaborative**—Create and sustain broad and sincere relationships among individuals and organizations to encourage trust, advocate a team atmosphere, building consensus, and facilitate communication.
6. **Coordinated**—Synchronize the activities of all relevant stakeholders to achieve a common purpose.
7. **Flexible**—Use creative and innovative approaches in solving disaster challenges
8. **Professional**—Value a science and knowledge-based approach on education, training, experience, Ethical practice, public stewardship and continuous improvement.

NAEM recognize the importance of emergency services and emergency support agencies as essential pieces of the emergency management puzzle. As participants in emergency management system, it is the “pulling together” of all elements of a local jurisdiction efforts that ensures an effective operation with respect to disasters.

The Nebraska Association of Emergency Management works to bring all participants together within one organization. NAEM encourages partnership between all agencies and individuals serving the interest of public safety in a disaster.
